

The Gotham Base Ball Club of New York and the Flemington Neshanock Base Ball Club will play by the rules of 1864, using authentic replicas of 19th Century equipment and wearing 19th Century uniforms. As was the custom in the mid-19th Century, all fielders play barehanded - no gloves. The two clubs are part of a large group of Vintage Base Ball Clubs that strive to present base ball's history to others by playing the game as it was done in the past. Each modern vintage team is based on a real historical team - the 1865 Gothams evolved into the Giants of today's National League. The original Flemington Neshanock team was comprised mainly of the town's prominent constituents. Their biggest rivals were the Lambertville Logans.
