Mr. Boswell's civil and environmental expertise includes an extensive working knowledge of site development, roadway design, water and wastewater systems, as well as treatment and pumping facilities. Mr. Boswell has served as the project leader on an extensive number of site developments in the private sector serving residential, commercial and industrial real estate. His projects involve environmental permitting, as well as testimony before numerous Municipal, County, State and Federal agencies.

Mr. Boswell also serves as an engineering consultant to numerous public sector clients. These clients include municipalities where he continues to serve in the capacity of the officially appointed Municipal Engineer, i.e. the City of Garfield, the Borough of Moonachie and the Borough of Oakland. Additionally, he serves as the Municipal Engineering Representative for the Township of Mahwah, the Boroughs of Franklin Lakes, Upper Saddle River and Cliffside Park. He has served as the project leader for numerous projects in the Counties of Bergen and Passaic for the past several decades.

His extensive knowledge of Water Supply, Wastewater and related infrastructure has allowed him to serve as a consultant on a wide array of roadway, sanitary sewer and water system improvements.

Another such Project which leveraged grants involved the widening of River Drive within the City of Garfield and construction of a riverfront park with a bikeway along the Passaic River. This award winning \$18M project utilized numerous grants totaling over \$16M.

Mr. Boswell also has an extensive background in the design of recreational facilities.
