JULY 28, 2020 UPDATE: IF YOU'RE TRAVELING TO NEW JERSEY FROM THE FOLLOWING STATES, YOU SHOULD QUARANTINE FOR 14 DAYS:

AK, AL, AR, AZ, CA, DC, DE, FL, GA, IA, ID, IL, IN, KS, KY, LA, MD, MN, MO, MS, MT, NC, ND, NE, NM, NV, OH, OK, PR, SC, TN, TX, UT, VA, WA, WI



If you're traveling to New Jersey from the following 36 states and territories, you should self-quarantine for 14 days:

AK, AL, AR, AZ, CA, DC, DE, FL, GA, IA, ID, IL, IN, KS, KY, LA, MD, MN, MO, MS, MT, NC, ND, NE, NM, NV, OH, OK, PR, SC, TN, TX, UT, VA, WA, WI

Illinois, Kentucky and Minnesota were included on the quarantine list after surpassing 10 average daily positive COVID-19 cases per 100,000 residents over the last week, as were Washington D.C. and Puerto Rico.
