**Authorization to The Place For The Athlete!
To Temporarily Conduct Its Recreation-Oriented
Business Within the Area of Its Parking Lot**

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has declared both a national emergency and public health emergency throughout the county as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy has similarly declared New Jersey to be in the midst of a public health emergency and state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has issued numerous Executive Orders which have, among other things, implemented certain restrictions on businesses, many of which have been required to close or temporarily suspend operations; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 107 required, with limited exceptions, New Jersey residents to remain in their residence and close all recreational and entertainment businesses; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 147 dated May 18, 2020, recognizing a decrease in New Jersey in the number of reported new cases of COVID-19, permitted certain outdoor recreation, businesses or activities closed pursuant to paragraph 9 of Executive Order No. 107; and

WHEREAS, The Place for the Athlete! (“the business”) is a business in the Borough of Upper Saddle River being located at 107 Pleasant Avenue and being more particularly located in Block 1012, Lot 30 (“the property”) as depicted on the Borough tax map; and

WHEREAS, said business has, prior to the issuance of Executive Order No. 107, conducted its recreation-oriented business indoors; and

WHEREAS, the business owner has requested that the Borough permit its recreational business operations to be conducted within the area of its parking lot on the property; and

WHEREAS, the use of this parking facility is not permitted under the Borough’s Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that it is necessary and

advisable during the current period of business restrictions to temporarily modify and suspend enforcement of Borough zoning regulations to assist this business to conduct its recreation-oriented activities within the exterior of its property, more particularly within its parking area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The business is hereby permitted to conduct its recreation-oriented business activities on the exterior of the property within the parking area on the property.
2. Such activities shall be permitted daily from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
3. Parking shall be monitored so as not to create any danger to patrons of the business during hours of operation. In connection therewith, the business shall comply with all reasonable recommendations of the Police Department in connection with its exterior operations.
4. The operator of the business shall be required to implement social distancing by the patrons of the business and adhere to all social distancing guidelines and requirements as may apply to public gatherings and events such as those contemplated by the business.
5. The within approval shall not be deemed to be permanent and shall not create any vested rights in the use of the exterior of the property and shall not constitute a precedent in any hearing, regardless of jurisdiction.
6. The permission herein granted shall be deemed to expire at 8:00 p.m. on September 30, 2020.

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE BERGEN COUNTY OPEN SPACE, RECREATION, FLOODPLAIN PROTECTION FARMLAND & HISTORIC PRESERVATION TRUST FUND FOR THE DEVELOPEMNT OF ONE LAKE STREET PARK

WHEREAS, the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund (“County Trust Fund”), provides matching grants to municipal governments and to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the development or redevelopment of outdoor municipal recreation facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of Upper Saddle River desires to further the public interest by obtaining a matching grant of \$500,000 from the County Trust Fund to fund the following project: Development of One Lake Street Park-Phase 1; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body has reviewed the County Trust Fund Program Statement and the Trust Fund Municipal Program Park Improvement application and instructions, and desires to make an application for such a matching grant and provide application information and furnish such documents as may be required; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the application process, the governing body held a public hearing on June 4, 2020 and held a second public hearing on July 2, 2020 after providing public notice in the The Record on June 19th & June 20th, 2020; and’

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen shall determine whether the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the County Trust Fund; and’

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the County Trust Fund in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the County of Bergen for the above-named project and ensure its completion on or about the project expiration date.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough of Upper Saddle River:

1. That it is authorized to submit the above completed project application to the County by the deadline of June 219, 2020, as established by the County: and,
2. That, in the event of a County Trust Fund award that may be less than the grant amount requested above, the Borough of Upper Saddle River has, or will secure, the balance of funding necessary to complete the project as necessary, and’

3. That the Borough of Upper Saddle River is committed to providing a dollar for dollar cash match for the project; and'
4. That only those park improvements identified and approved in the project application, its Trust Fund contract, or other documentation will be considered eligible for reimbursement.
5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
