



Stop by for A Veterans Tour at the Old Stone Church Cemetery

Sunday, May 28
11:30 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.

In honor of their service to their country, all veterans' graves will be marked with an American flag for Memorial Day. More than 90 of those veterans served in the Revolutionary War, the Civil War, World War I, World War II, the Korean War or Vietnam War.

On Sunday, May 28, come wander along the cemetery paths, situated behind the landmark 200-year-old church with the Saddle River meandering along the west boundary, view these grave sites and read their stories in a handout. Volunteers from the Old Stone Church and the USR Historical Society will share photos and additional information.

Admission is free. Parking is available in the main lot, just north of the cemetery. Additional parking in front of and behind the Educational Building, corner of Weiss Road.



There are nine Revolutionary War grave sites in the Old Stone Church Cemetery, including the one above for Jacob C. Eckerson, who died in 1838 at age 90
